

Prescott Valley, AZ is a Childcare Desert

For nearly 50 years the YMCA of Yavapai County has been a trusted partner in serving Yavapai County. Prescott Valley is one of the fastest growing non-urban communities in our nation, yet with every step of growth the community falls dangerously behind in:

- Protecting and Supporting At-Risk Children and Families
- Protecting the Elderly and other Vulnerable Populations
- Providing New Jobs, Job Training and Internship Opportunities
- Creating a Culture based on Respect, Caring, Responsibility and Honesty

According to the study published by US Chamber of Commerce Foundation, the 2021 economic impact of the Childcare Deficit in Arizona was \$1.77 B. On a per capita basis, this translates to an annual adverse impact of over \$15 M on the economy of the Town of Prescott Valley, all due to its inability to meet its childcare needs. The creation of the new YMCA, and its proposed Child Development wing will:

- Directly create over 200 jobs in the Prescott Valley Community
- Enable hundreds of parents, who are unable to work due to the cost of childcare, to return to work.
- Enable at-risk and minority populations to access childcare so that they can enter the Jobs Training program offered by Yavapai College.
- Provide Childcare Internships and jobs for newly trained childcare providers.
- Bring proven YMCA programs to the entire Prescott Valley community.

For all of these reasons and more, the YMCA of Yavapai County seeks funding support for the creation of its \$3M Child Development center in its plan for the new YMCA in Prescott Valley
