# LIFEGUARD CERTIFICATION COURSES SUMMER 2020:

- Will receive certification in: Lifeguarding, First Aid, CPR/AED for the professional rescuer, Administering Emergency Oxygen, and Bloodborne Pathogens
- Must be at least 15 years of age to register
- Must pass pre-requisites
- In order to be successful: Must pass two written exams, skill scenarios, attend every class session, come prepared to class every day, and arrive to class on time.
- Must complete online portion prior to the first full day of class (registration process on back)

- 1. Open an internet browser (preferably Firefox, Chrome, or Edge)
- 2. Go to: www.prescottymca.org
- 3. Click Programs
- 4. Click Certifications
- 5. Find where it states Link to American Red Cross Lifeguard Online Portion
- 6. Create a username and password
- 7. Close the entire internet browser
- 8. Reopen the browser and complete steps 1-5
- 9. Login using the newly created account information
- 10. Click launch course or begin
- 11. Complete the ENTIRE link before the first official day of class (not pre-requisites day)
- 12. Bring your completion certification to class on day 1.

### How did you hear about our Lifeguard training? \_\_\_\_\_

I understand I or my child must be able to complete the pre-requisites for the course which include a 300 yard swim, 20 yard 10 pound brick retrieval in 1 minute 30 seconds, and 2 minutes of treading with no hands. The student must have access to a computer and internet to complete the online portion of the class prior to the first official day of class. Payment must be received after completing the pre-requisites but before the first day of class.
