Tuesday, September 1

“Greenways” – Two mile out and back trail along granite creek to mile high middle school, with lots of foliage and deciduous trees. This is an urban hike through the city.

Level: 1

Directions: Park in the Sprouts Shopping Center near Staples. Path to park is located on sidewalk next to Staples.

Thursday, September 3

“Mint Wash - Trail #308” – Moderate out and back through the Granite Mountain Wilderness area.

Level: 3

Directions: Take Iron Springs Road to Williamson Valley Road and turn right. Drive north approximately 6.5 miles. Turn into the Williamson Valley Trailhead parking area on left immediately before fire station.

Tuesday, September 8

“Walden Farms Trail”- Newer trail starting on the opposite side of Constellation and eventually meeting the Peavine Trail. Out and back.

Level: 2

Directions: From State Hwy 89 exit at the Phippen exit, parking at the improved Constellation Trail Head parking. **COP FEE AREA.**

Thursday, September 10

“FS #738” –Lollipop loop on FS Trail 738 which follows contours through the pines with some elevation gain. We will go counterclockwise starting on 738 then come back down by the creek and pick up 738 again having almost reached the intersection of #264.

Level: 2

Directions: Go west on Gurley Street approximately 1 mile past Thumb Butte Recreation area. Park at White Rock parking area.

Tuesday, September 15

“Ponderosa Park Rd to Indian Creek” – Stroll among the dense pines to open meadows winding up at an old State Park with some surprises.

Level: 2

Directions: Go out White Spar Road about 3 miles past Safeway (about one mile past the White Spar Campground) turn left onto Ponderosa Park Road and park about 20 yards down (on either side of the road) on the dirt pullouts.

Thursday, September 17

“Almosta Trail” #622- This is a county trail that starts at the Almosta Trailhead and then becomes Trail #622 once it enters Prescott National Forest. This is a pleasant hike over ridge tops and through riparian areas. The trail can be narrow in spots and there are a couple of short, steep climbs.

Level: 3

Directions: From its intersection with Iron Springs Road, travel north on Williamson Valley Road for 12.5 miles to Almosta Ranch Road. Turn left on Almosta Ranch Road and proceed 0.7 miles to the trailhead on the left. Parking is good.

Tuesday, September 22

“Feldmeier Trail” – Newer trail near Goldwater Lake that follows parallel with Senator Hwy intersecting Banning Creek Trail #330. This is a beautiful hike through an open Ponderosa Pine forest. This is an out and back hike.

Level: 2

Directions: From Gurley Street, take Mt. Vernon Street (turns into Senator Highway). The trailhead is on the left about ½ mile past the entrance to Goldwater Lake. This is the same parking area that is used for trails 62 and 299.

Thursday, September 24

“Firewater” – Trail starts on #318 and replaces a former social trail (accessed at the SE corner of parking area). Firewater, #325, is an interesting trail that climbs up through the pines from Willow Creek, but starts out on the Prescott Circle Trail by the Chimney Ruin.

Directions: From the Courthouse Plaza, drive west out of Prescott on Gurley Street for 5.0 miles to the White Rock parking area on the right immediately past the Camp Willow Springs Rd.

Level 3.5

Tuesday, September 29

“Peavine North Trail/Side Rd – Flat, gravel surface that follows the old Santa Fe railroad line.

Level: 1

Directions: From Highway 89, turn east on Pioneer Parkway/ 89A, and then get off highway at Granite Dells Parkway. Turn onto Centerpointe East then right onto Side rd to parking area.
