Tuesday, November 2

“Williamson Valley Trail #308- Easy out and back stroll on a good trail surface with few obstacles and minimal elevation change. Views of Granite Mountain.

Level: 2

Directions: Take Iron Springs Rd., west to Williamson Valley Road and turn right. Drive north approximately 6.5 miles. Turn left into the Williamson Valley Trailhead area.

Thursday, November 4

“Thumb Butte South trails 326, 392, and 367” – Loop hike in the pines. This hike begins at the Thumb Butte parking area and descends back.

Level: 3

Directions: Go west on Gurley Street (turns into Thumb Butte Road) until you enter Thumb Butte Park. Parking on the right. **USES FEE AREA**. To carpool, meet at the bowling alley.
