**Tuesday, October 5**

**“Butte Creek”**– Trail winds by the side of the Hassayampa golf course and development area. Rolling trail offers nice views of golf course. Will be an out and back hike; fairly steep.

Level: 3

Directions: Go west on Gurley Street to Sherwood Drive, one block past the entrance to Hassayampa Village. Turn left on Sherwood and follow it until you see Stricklin Park on your left. Park along road and walk across the creek to the trailhead.

**Thursday, October 7**

**“Badger Mountain”** – Beautiful dirt trail with rolling hills and steep grades in places. Panoramic views of Prescott.

Level: 3.5

Directions: Take Gurley Street, going south and turn right on Robinson. Go approximately .15 of a mile and turn left on Butterfield Road. Go approximately .4 mile and veer right onto Wells Fargo Road. Go approximately .2 mile and turn right at the Turley Trail sign (between 1507 and 1509 Wells Fargo Rd.). Go down the very narrow lane, through the gate (close gate again), and park.

**Tuesday, October 12**

**“Flume Trail to Watson Dam”**- The Flume Trail leaves the trailhead on Granite Dells Road and heads toward the base of the Watson Lake Dam. There is some overland hiking eventually leading to Granite Creek and up to the base of the Dam. This can be an out and back hike or a “lollipop hike” involving some connecting trails that climb out of the creek bottom.

Level: 3

Directions: From the Watson Lake roundabout on Hwy 89, drive North on Hwy 89 to Granite Dells Road. Turn right on Granite Dells road and watch for the parking area to the right. There is limited parking at the trailhead. Carpool from Watson lake Park off Hwy 89 if possible. There is no fee for parking at the trailhead, however, if you carpool from Watson Lake Park you will be in a **C.O.P Fee Area**

### **Thursday, October 14**

**“Firewater”** — Trail starts on #318 and replaces a former social trail (accessed at the SE corner of parking area). Firewater, #325, is an interesting trail that climbs up through the pines from Willow Creek, but starts out on the Prescott Circle Trail by the Chimney Ruin.

Directions: From the Courthouse Plaza, drive west out of Prescott on Gurley Street for 5.0 miles to the White Rock parking area on the right immediately past the Camp Willow Springs Rd.

### **Tuesday, October 19**

**“Wolverton” #9415** – Out and back on single track trail with great views of Prescott.

Level: 3

Directions: Go out White Spar Road about 2 miles past Safeway. Turn left into White Spar campground and immediately park on the right.

### **Thursday, October 21**

**“Yeager Cabin Trail 533”** - Steep trail. Out and back on the right-hand side of Yeager Cabin Trail. Several options will be available.

Level: 4+

Directions: From the intersection of Viewpoint Drive and Highway 89A in Prescott Valley, continue on Hwy 89A past the fairgrounds. Turn right on Road 151, just past the power lines. We will carpool to the trailhead from the parking area at the power lines.

### **Tuesday, October 26**

**“White Rock to old Girl Scout Trail back on #318”** - Hike through the National Forest from White Rock parking area.

Level: 2.5

Directions: From the Courthouse Plaza, drive west out of Prescott on Gurley Street for 5.0 miles to the White Rock parking area on the right immediately past the Camp Willow Springs Rd.

### **Thursday, October 28**

**“Wolf Creek Falls Trail #384”** – A short, wide but steep trail leads from Wolf Creek Road to Wolf Creek. We will walk along narrow paths that parallel (a probably dry) creek bed to its confluence with the Hassayampa River.

Level: 3.5

Directions: Take Mount Vernon/Senator Highway past Groom Creek to Wolf Creek Road (just past where the road turns to dirt). Turn right on Wolf Creek Road and go about 1 mile to Wolf Creek Lower Campground – park on right.
